Tefilla



Miss Kaufman gave a very powerful Tefilla lesson. She explained that Hashem created the world in an incomplete way to give humans the responsibility to perfect the world (Tikkun Olam) and to realize their dependence on Hashem. Because the world is incomplete, we use Tefilla to ask Hashem for His help. Morah also explained the proper way to daven: first we praise Hashem, second we ask for what we would like, and lastly we thank Him.
